ORDINANCE NO. 00-03

AN ORDINANCE TO PROMOTE  
THE SAFETY AND NAVIGABILITY OF THE  
WATERS OF LAKE HIGHLAND

SECTION 1. Purpose

It is the expressed purpose of this ordinance to provide for the protection of Lake Highland, it's navigability and water quality. To maintain the depth of the waters thereof and to insure the safety of the boating public.

SECTION II. Safety and Navigability.

In order to promote the safety and navigability of the lake, it is necessary to increase the depth of certain areas of the lake and to prevent future conditions which may endanger boating traffic. Such conditions include but are not limited to siltation and sedimentation.


SECTION III. Abatement of Water Hazards


The Mayor of the the Town of Highland Lake is hereby authorized to enter into contract with a certified contractor, being the lowest bidder, subject to section 34-11-10 code of Alabama 1975. for the removal of such water hazards and that payment of such contract be authorized upon completion pursuant to Section 11-47-5 code of Alabama 1975.

SECTION IV. Appropriation of Funds

Funds appropriated for payment of the contract shall be drawn from funds earmarked for such purpose, from the Special Projects fund and/or grants.
