AN ORDINANCE REGULATING ACTIVITIES AND THE TYPE, SIZE, USE
AND HORSEPOWER OF WATERCRAFT ON THE WATERS OF HIGHLAND
LAKE AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF
AND ADOPTING THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE STATE OF
ALABAMA REGARDING BOATING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF HIGHLAND LAKE,
ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Watercraft Prohibited.

The following watercraft are prohibited from the waters of Highland Lake:

- A) All watercraft over 21 feet in length with the exception of pontoon boats and sailboats which may be up to 28 feet in length.

Passed and adopted this 2nd day of May 2005. This amendment shall be effective five (5) days from and after the date of its adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. HL 93-03

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING ACTIVITIES AND THE TYPE, SIZE, USE
AND HORSEPOWER OF WATERCRAFT ON THE WATERS OF
HIGHLAND LAKE AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES
FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND
ADOPTING THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF
THE STATE OF ALABAMA REGARDING BOATING

SECTION 1: Watercraft Prohibited.

The following watercraft are prohibited from the waters of Highland Lake:

- A) All watercraft over 20 feet in length with the exception of pontoon boats which may be up to 28 feet in length.
- B) Airboats of any type that use aircraft propellers for propulsion.
- C) Hydroplanes or racing boats of any size unless participation in an organized event approved by the Mayor and the City Council.
- D) Engine size shall not exceed the recommended horsepower as provided by the manufacturer and as is indicated on the United State Coast Guard Capacity Plate.

SECTION 2: Operations.

- A) This ordinance adopts the Rules and Regulations the Alabama Safe Boating Law and The United States Guard pertaining to:
 - 1. Operations.
 - 2. Safety Devices.
 - 3. Flotation Devices.
 - 4. Water Sports.
- B) No one shall operate a power boat at any speed as to cause excessive wake in fishing areas or other restricted areas as designated and marked.
- C) Swimming shall be prohibited in areas so marked.

SECTION 3:

BE IT FURHTER ORDAINED, that within said Codes when reference is made to the dities of certain official~~s~~s named therein, the designated official in the Town of Highland Lake, who has duties corresponding to thoseof the named official in said Code, shall be deemed t~~i~~d be the responsible official insofar as enforcing the provisions of said Code are concerned.

SECTION 4:

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
