ORDINANCE NO. HL 93-11

AN ORDINANCE TO SUPERSEDE ORDINANCE NO. HL 89-02
AND ORDINANCE NO. HL 89-03 REGARDING PRESERVATION
AND PROHIBITIONS RELATING TO THE HIGHLAND LAKE DAM
AND PROHIBITION OF THE DRELLING OF WELLS, ETC.

SECTION 1: Highland Lake Dam.

It shall be unlawful for any person to work on, work with, tamper with or in any manner manipulate the Highland Lake Dam so as to alter or affect the flow of water unless such person has been specifically authorized by a resolution adopted by the Town Council of the Town of Highland Lake at a duly held meeting of said council.

SECTION 2:

It shall be unlawful for any person to drill or cause to be drilled at a well within the town limits of the Town of Highland Lake, Alabama.

SECTION 3:

It Shall be unlawful for any person to interfere with the flow of and the waterways leading to highland lake in the town limits of the Town of Highland Lake, Alabama.

SECTION 4:

Any person who is convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

SECTION 5:

This ordinance supersedes Ordinance No. HL 89-02 and Ordinance No. HL 89-03 in their entirety.
