TOWN OF HIGHLAND LAKE  
ORDINANCE NO. 94-01

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town Highland Lake, Alabama, that the rate of Ad Valorem taxes as specified in Ordinance H-2 (5 mills) and in Ordinance H-4 (7 1/2 mills) for respective years 1968 and 1969, and each and every fiscal year thereafter successively and continuously, shall be combined increases restated in the amount of 12 1/2 mills. That all real estate and personal property within the corporate limits of said town shall be increased in the rate of assessment an additional 12 1/2 mills, shall be collected by the Tax Collector for Blount County, Alabama, as provided by law, both of whom shall be paid for their services two (2) percent for assessing and two (2) percent for collecting as provided by Alabama State Law.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Highland Lake, Alabama, that the rate of 12 1/2 mills be and the same is hereby assessed by all motor vehicles owned by citizens within the corporate limits of said town, such assessment to be made by the Tax Assessor for Blount County, Alabama, as Town Tax, as provided by law, and both of whom shall be paid for their services two (2) percent for assessing and two (2) percent for collecting as provided by Alabama State Law.

FURTHER, that after the deduction of such commissions, the Blount County Tax Collector shall remit to the Town Treasure, Highland Lake, Alabama, the amount collected monthly as such tax, less the commission herein above approved.


FURTHER, all Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance be, and are hereby repealed.
