


AN ORDINANCE REGARDING LOAD LIMITS ON ALL ROADS
WITHIN THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND LAKE


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF HIGHLAND
LAKE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:


Load limits on all roads within the town limits of the Town of Highland
Lake shall be 60,000 pounds gross weight.







ORDINANCE NO. HL 96-02

LOAD LIMITS ON ALL ROADS WITHIN THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND LAKE

Load limits on all roads within the town limits of the Town of Highland Lake shall be 40,000 pounds per load or 4000 pounds per load carrying wheel.

Repair of damaged roads shall be the responsibility of the hauler. The extent and quality of repairs will be specified by Blount County Commissioner District No. 3.

Multiple hauling projects must be approved by the Town Council prior to the start of the project.
