The Highland Lake Town Council held its work session on Tuesday, February 02, 2021. Mayor Donna Hanby called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m. and presented the following items for review.

Two visitors from Marshall County's Cherokee Ridge sub-division attended to observe and inquire, regarding their efforts to incorporate Cherokee Ridge as a Town. Many issues were discussed and they were very grateful for the suggestions.

1. Credit Card Options for accepting website payments was discussed. This will be further researched.
 2. Discussed offering daily boat permit for \$35.00. This idea was not popular with residents nor Council due to the inability to monitor who was actually on lake and the fact it might possibly take away from the annual fishing permits.
 3. Discussed Code & Ordinance Violation form and decided that changes would need to be made to the overall program in an effort for Town to collect various fines within 30 days before going to court.
 4. FEMA processing is coming along good after 3 inspections. Tim is waiting for a breakdown on charges from Blount County for Vista, Bear Creek Circle and culvert.
 5. Bridge inspection went well. The only item noted was needed removal of leaves and debris on Brasher Creek bridge.
 6. Don & Sherry Timberlake, 510 Lakeshore Lane - boat house/pier drawings were presented for consideration.
 7. Stepping stones installation completed at foot bridge area.
 8. Mayor Hanby reviewed the upcoming price increases for Business Licenses, Building Permits and Waterfront property landowners.
 9. Discussed items on February Newsletter.
