ORDINANCE NO HL 2022-01

**AN AMENDMENT TO ESTABLISH SPEED LIMITS ON THE ROADS
WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS OF HIGHLAND LAKE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND LAKE,
ALABAMA:

Section 1:


The speed limits herein after specified, or established as hereinafter authorized, shall be the maximum lawful speeds, for the corporate limits of the city, and no person shall drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of the maximum limits.

Section 2: Speed limits


- West Lakeshore Drive – 25 MPH
- Lakeshore Loop – 20 MPH
- Echo Lane – 20 MPH
- Martin Drive – 20 MPH
- Highland Lake Dam Road, starting at the city limits shall be – 20 MPH
- Lakeshore Lane – 20 MPH
- Bear Creek Circle – 20 MPH
- Sunset Strip – 15 MPH
- Sunset Boulevard, including West Sunset and East Sunset – 20 MPH
- Lakeshore Circle – 20 MPH
- Vista Drive – 20 MPH
- Hope Drive – 20 MPH
- Kennedy Drive – 25 MPH
- Wofford Drive – 15 MPH
- Lakeshore Drive – 25 MPH – except for 3/10 of a mile from County Highway 29, which is the S curve area, to Brasher Creek, shall be 15 MPH.

When adopted, this Ordinance shall replace Ordinance No. HL-97-04 and the Amendment to Ordinance HL-97-04.
