ITEMS DISCUSSED:

Review and discussion of the November 7 regular meeting agenda items took place.

Zoning Board of Adjustments Member Appointments – New appointments will need to be made at the December monthly council meeting to replace Olivia Brodock (one year term expires) and Gail Bailey (resigning). Council members should advise Mayor Vice of any potential candidates.

Regular Scheduled Council Meeting Date – the council is receptive to possibly changing the monthly meeting to the second Tuesday of each month.

Lights in the Park Grant – solar lights for the park were discussed, as well as lights for the Gazebo. The Buildings & Grounds Committee will review and make a recommendation for the council to consider.

Mosquito Sprayer – Determine Whether to Keep Equipment for Future Use - everyone was in agreement to keep the sprayer for use in the park area as needed.

Plans for Fountain in the Park – the water in the fountain has been replaced with plants. This should resolve the maintenance issue. The council thanked Gail Bailey for handling this project. Mrs. Bailey requested a small hole be drilled in the fountain so it will not hold water. Tim Moore agreed to handle.

Review/Discuss Road Forms – Review and discussion took place on five road forms that have been submitted by residents.


Other items discussed:
