**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING
ANNUAL NON-RESIDENT LAKE USE PERMIT
FOR KAYAKS/CANOES**

WHEREAS, This Resolution shall be for a period of one (1) year starting May 15, 2022 and ending May 14, 2023.

WHEREAS, This Lake Use Permit is for non-residents and will cover one (1) non-motorized vessel, i.e., canoe or kayak.

WHEREAS, A Life Vest Preserver is mandatory and should be worn at all times while on the water.

WHEREAS, the fee for this Lake Use Permit will be Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for the first Kayak and a second Kayak or canoe may be added for an additional One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00.)


WHEREAS, At the end of the period of May 14, 2022 the Council will decide whether to continue this Lake Use Permit.

WHEREAS, A maximum of ten (10) permits will be issued for the year defined above.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Council of Highland Lake an annual non-resident lake use permit for non-motorized vessels will be approved for one year as defined above.


